People with disabilities want quality, affordable housing where they can be part of a small community, feel safe and secure and have the necessary support they need to live a full and happy life and reach their full potential. A place they can call "**HOME**".

Families want peace of mind knowing their loved ones are safe and happy.

People with disabilities and mental health issues are amongst the most vulnerable in our community. There is a significant risk that these people, without assistance, could face homelessness.

This is because of barriers finding accommodation due to lack of income (living off DSP), lack of quality/affordable housing and potential discrimination in the rental market.



Who are we



The Carinbundi Foundation is a registered charity and relies on community support to continue providing accommodation for people with intellectual and/or physical disabilities in the Bundaberg region.

It is not just about providing houses for people with disabilities - it is much more than that.

We build houses that become homes where residents are free to be themselves, where they feel safe and secure and can share with like-minded friends. These houses will be their "forever homes". As a not-for-profit we can offer homes at less than market rental rates - giving residents additional money each week to go out and be part of their community. **We want inclusiveness to be affordable.**

These homes will be close to community amenities where residents can visit their local shops and become integral members of their community.
